



Update From The Winton Community Support Office

I write this as I sit in my makeshift office at home, my workload is not as high as I thought it might be, my hours are filled with making contact with some elderly and generally checking on those whom are reasonably isolated.

I've arranged a small amount of people to go grocery shopping but even this seems to be not as highly sought after as we thought it would be. A few transport requests have been completed by some younger volunteers as our usual volunteer drivers are all in that vulnerable or 'at risk' category.

The Winton NZ Community Support face book page as proved to be an integral communication tool during this lock down period, people have used it as a means of getting in touch, it's great for getting information out to the community and for sharing ideas for parents to do with their kids to help fill in the days and I've even used it to run a colouring competition for all ages.

A couple of flyers that have gone out to mailboxes both here in Winton and also out to the RD's have provided useful information and contacts to our community, in particular information regarding the essential services both further afield and here in Winton. I know from feedback I have received these flyers have been useful to many.

From my perspective our community is coping really well during this trying time. People are looking out for family, elderly and neighbours. Demand to this point on the food bank has been minimal and the food bank is very well stocked should this change in the coming weeks. A massive shout out to the people who have donated meat for the freezer; it went from being next to empty to fill to the brim within the course of a morning. Also, to Winton New World who have made a very generous donation to our food bank. I have said it many times, this is truly an amazingly generous community in which we live!

Anzac Day took on a new way of remembrance and in my neighbourhood, it was quite special. As I quietly took my place in the shelter of my door just before 6 am I noticed that most of my neighbours lights were also on, as 6 o'clock came around a loud speaker from a few doors away broke the silence with the national dawn service, and we were even treated to a lone piper and Amazing Grace! So, I'm sure I can say on behalf of anyone else who listened to this in the dark still of ANZAC morning, thank you to my neighbours, once again the community spirit was quite outstanding!

Finally I just want to share something I read a few days ago about what people would remember the most about their time in lock down in 20- or 30-years' time. It is thought that adults will remember the inability to go to work, social distancing and being stuck at home with the family; whereas children will more than likely remember fun times at home, doing things as a family, going for walks, bike rides, baking with Mum (or Dad), being schooled from home, going on bear hunts and making things to commemorate ANZAC Day of 2020.

What ever it is that will stick in your mind, I hope that the memories are going to be happy ones and that perhaps the situation has encouraged you and your family to think about the good parts of lockdown that might become your new normal. Stay safe everyone.

From 8am Tuesday 28th April 2020 we will be open for business with our usual hours under Alert Level 3. Things will look a little bit different for us but we wanted to keep you in the loop!

Our workshop will be open to full capacity. For all work required please book in with Justin on the phone, email or DMs. As always our yard remains drive-through for your convenience and safety. We are taking bookings for the workshop and parts/orders now in preparation for Tuesday.

For all bikes delivered to our drive-through for servicing, maintenance, repairs, rebuilds etc. our preference at Alert Level 3 is that you bring your own ramps and attend to your own unloading/ loading. Should you not have your own ramps or be unable to unload/ load your bike (e.g. the likes of Mrs Motoworx who simply doesn't know how) please let us know at the time of booking and we will arrange for Nathan or Justin to sort it while you remain safely in your vehicle.

Our showroom will be closed at Level 3 but Justin will be instore and should you require anything from new bikes to parts, helmets, boots, riding gear, tyres, oil, chain lube or any of our other products please do call, email or DM Justin. He can arrange contactless pick up/payment via our drive through drop zone at the big roller door at the back of our showroom. This will be marked as drop zone. All items will be labelled with your name. Payments should also be contactless (online or over the phone).

Given the size of our premises in comparison to the size of our staff we are able to operate very safely while maximising social distancing. The welfare of our staff is of the highest importance to us and for that reason the youngest member of our team (James) will not be returning until a lower alert level. Sanitising and hygiene systems have been put in place and our staff have been informed.
